Before we end our trip in Barcelona, one of Europe's most cosmopolitan and joyful cities with its unique, still unfinished Church of Sagrada Familia, we will visit the famous Monastery of Montserrat with its venerated 6<sup>th</sup> century statue of the Black Madonna.

# DEPART BUFFALO/TORONTO/ ACROSS THE ATLANTIC

#### MON, MAY 12

Depart Buffalo today by bus to Toronto and connect with your overnight transatlantic jet flight to Madrid, arriving the following day.

#### **ARRIVE MADRID**

#### TUE, MAY 13

Your exciting adventure begins as you arrive today in Madrid. Transfer to your hotel and enjoy the balance of the day at leisure. (D)

#### MADRID

#### WED, MAY 14

On this morning's visit of the city, you will see the white-trimmed 2,800-room Royal Palace and the exquisite gardens that surround it. Other highlights include the Puerta del Sol, Cervantes Memorial, the Plaza de Espana and the acacia-lined Castellana. Then visit the Prado Museum, housing a collection of masterpieces by Spain's artists Velazquez, Goya and El Greco. This afternoon will be at leisure. **(B)** 

# MADRID – AVILA/SEGOVIA

#### THU, MAY 15

This morning drive to the walled city of Avila, the birthplace and home of St. Teresa, the founder of the Order of the Carmelites. Visit the Monastery of the

Incarnation, where Teresa entered Carmel, made her Solemn Profession and lived for the next 25 years. Also, visit the foundation of the reform, St. Joseph Monastery. See the beautiful Plaza de Santa Teresa and other sites connected with her life. Continue to Segovia, famous for its magnificent Roman Aqueduct and Cathedral, one of the last Gothic buildings built in Europe. Visit the church of St. John of the Cross before returning to Madrid for the night. **(B)** 

#### MADRID/TOLEDO/CORDOBA FRI, MAY 16

Depart this morning for Toledo, the ancient Castilian capital that sits high on a hilltop ringed by Visigoth walls and circled by a loop of the Tagus River resembling a moat. Visit the 13<sup>th</sup> century Cathedral containing priceless jeweled chalices and paintings. Continue to Cordoba for the night. **(B,D)** 

#### CORDOBA/SEVILLE

#### SAT, MAY 17

This morning enjoy an orientation tour of Cordoba before departing for Seville, capital of Andalucia for the night. (B,D)

#### SEVILLE

#### SUN, MAY 18

This morning visit Alcazar Palace and the ornate cathedral with Columbus' tomb and Giralda Tower. Also see Maria Luisa Park, City Hall, the Gold Tower and the area of the April Fair described by Hemingway. The balance of the day is free. You may want to wander out tonight and experience one of Seville's many local establishments where you can enjoy Flamenco dancing. (B)

#### SEVILLE/GRANADA

#### MON, MAY 19

Depart this morning to the 8th century Moorish stronghold of Granada in the foothills of the Sierra Nevada Range. This afternoon your sightseeing includes visits to the Rotonda del Generalife, summer palace of Moorish princes, plus the Alhambra, an ornate, Arabesque confection in pink granite. You will have time to explore the gardens and grounds before going to dinner and your hotel. (B,D)

# **GRANADA/VALENCIA**

# TUES, MAY 20

Enjoy a free morning on your own. Then you drive past the many olive and orange groves of the rolling Andalusian hills and then through the barren landscapes of Don Quixote's La Mancha as you head northwards to Valencia. (B,D)

#### VALENCIA/MONTSERRAT/BARCELONA WED, MAY 21

This morning you depart Valencia and head to Barcelona, considered to be the cultural center of Spain. On the way stop at the dramatically set 12<sup>th</sup> century Benedictine Archabbey of Montserrat. Perched high on sheer rock rising abruptly from the Catalonian plain, it is the spiritual heart of Catalonia. Pilgrims have been visiting Monserrat for over 700 years. Visit the royal Basilica where you will see the venerated 6<sup>th</sup> century statue of the Black Madonna, Our Lady of Montserrat. After your visit, continue to Barcelona and your hotel for the night. **(B,D)** 

#### BARCELONA


# THU, MAY 22

Barcelona is the cultural and political center of Catalonia and Spain's most European city. The city itself is divided into two major parts: the older area symbolized by the Gothic Quarter and the more modern part with its wide avenues. This morning enjoy a city tour including a visit to the Gothic Quarter. See the Gothic palaces of the Government of Catalonia and the City Hall, the world-famous Cathedral with its fine medieval cloister and arcades, and view from the outside the towering La Sagrada Familia Church designed by the Catalonian architect Antoni Gaudí. Begun in 1882, the church is still under construction today. The afternoon is at leisure to further explore this magnificent city on your own. (B)

#### BARCELONA/TORONTO/BUFFALO FRI, MAY 23

Your adventure is over as you board your flight back to Toronto, arriving the same day and your bus back home to Buffalo. (B)
