DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

DEPART BUFFALO/TORONTO

MON, JUN 8

Drive to Toronto today by bus and board your transatlantic flight to Ireland arriving the following day.

ARRIVE DUBLIN/ARMAGH/BELFAST

TUE, JUN 9

Upon arrival at Dublin Airport you will meet your driver/guide and board your motor coach. Head to the ancient city of Armagh, the ecclesiastical capital of Ireland, and enjoy an orientation tour. Continue on to Belfast, the capital city of Northern Ireland located on the river Lagan for overnight stay. (D)

BELFAST/DOWNPATRICK/BELFAST

WED, JUN 10

Once a major industrial city known especially for its master ship builders, Belfast has transformed itself into a major cultural center. On your morning sightseeing tour in this Victorian designed city you will see Queens University and the Titanic Quarter where the tragic liner was built. Also view the City Hall built in 1903 and the Albert Memorial Clock Tower. This afternoon, drive south to the town of Downpatrick to visit the burial site of St. Patrick. Return to Belfast for the night. (B,D)

BELFAST/GIANT'S CAUSEWAY/DERRY

THU, JUN 11

Depart today and drive along the northeastern coast to view the Nine Glens of Antrim and continue to visit the famous Giant's Causeway. It is one of nature's most spectacular wonders—40,000 six-sided symmetrical lava columns that range in size from 2 inches to 36 feet. The causeway was formed by volcanic activity over 60 million years ago and today is recognized as a World Conservation site. Continue to Derry for a walking tour including the Guildhall with its famous stained glass windows and the historic Walls of Derry. (B,D)

DERRY/DONEGAL/KNOCK/GALWAY

FRI, JUN 12

This morning journey through County Donegal and drive along the Barnesmore Gap past the Blue Stack mountain range and the picturesque Donegal Town. Continue to follow the western coast through "Yeats Country" and head south to County Mayo to visit the village of Knock. Regarded, as the premier place of pilgrimage and shrine to our Lady in Ireland, it was here in Knock that the blessed Mother appeared at the little parish church in 1879. Later continue to your hotel in the Galway area for overnight. **(B,D)**

GALWAY/CONNEMARA/GALWAY

SAT, JUN 13

Today, drive through the wild, majestic Connemara region, home of Aran knits. Your tour embraces the rugged country lying between Lough Corrib and the Atlantic Ocean, a breathtaking region of mountains, lakes and tiny cottages, visiting Leenane, Clifden, and Kylemore Lakes. Here, St. Patrick fasted for 40 days and nights. Return to the Galway area for overnight. **(B)**

GALWAY/CLIFFS OF MOHER/KILLARNEY

SUN, JUN 14

Depart Galway today stopping enroute in a local village to see the awe-inspiring Cliffs of Moher soaring hundreds of feet above the sea. Continue south through County Clare. Drive by the picturesque village of Ardara to Killarney, located in the kingdom of Kerry. **(B,D)**

RING OF KERRY

MON, JUN 15

Today you have an opportunity to enjoy what is perhaps Ireland's most breathtaking tour. Spend the day exploring the 109-mile "Ring of Kerry," encircling the Iveragh Peninsula, a panorama of spectacular coastal and mountain scenery along golden beaches. Pass beautiful lakes, quaint little villages and drive along the rugged Atlantic shore before returning to Killarney where the balance of the day is at leisure. **(B)**

KILLARNEY/BLARNEY CASTLE/CASHEL/DUBLIN

TUE, JUN 16

This morning our travels turn eastward as we drive onward to Blarney Castle to visit the legendary Blarney Stone, said to bestow the gift of eloquent speech on those who kiss it. Then drive to Cork, a lovely old city of dreamy spires and elegant limestone buildings, located on the River Lee. See the famed Rock of Cashel with its medieval buildings dating back to the 12th century. Continue to Dublin for overnight. **(B)**

DUBLIN

WED, JUN 17

Your tour of Dublin this morning includes include St. Patrick's Cathedral, Phoenix Park and the fine old Georgian Squares of Merrion and Fitzwilliam for which the city is renowned. Visit the Guinness Brewery and enjoy a tasting. This afternoon is free for independent activities. **(B,D)**

DUBLIN/TORONTO/BUFFALO


THU, JUN 18
